# 1 Minutes of the meeting held 9.2.11 and matters arising not otherwise on the agenda

  - St Albans DC have issued a consultation document on their section of the route. Adam has a copy and will send to members. Action Adam

  - o Lost Railways information board: This is being supplied following an exhibition at St Albans Museum. Agreed the best location is probably near the steps to the former Lemsford Road Halt. Cathy is arranging installation. **Action Cathy:** No news.
- Petition: A petition to Herts CC asking for cycle paths to schools. At the time of the meeting 254 people had signed this. Thanks to all for encouraging this.
