Welwyn Hatfield Cycling Forum: Minutes of meeting held 15th February 2012

- 2 Update on "BikeWatch", Jay Patel, Community Safety Partnership Co-ordinator, WHBC, Ben Satchfield, PC and Nish Chelvachandran PCSO.

Nish explained to the forum a bit more about how the OWL system works and how he sees Bike Watch fitting into this. Jay Patel is now trained to use the system. Its all about 2 way communication. The Forum will only cover the Welwyn Hatfield area, we can use the system to send details of rides and events to those signed up The Forum agreed to go ahead and become involved in this scheme. The amount of traffic is about 2 or 3 messages per month, the co-ordinator adds these, users have lower access to the system, the co-ordinator has higher access. Chris Whitehouse volunteered to act as Administrator. He and Nish to contact each other direct to set some training up, once this is complete we need to agree a "go live" date and possibly a launch event, this could include bike marking.

At the last meeting it was asked if there was any mapping of problem spots, Jay reported back that there were no specifics so mapping was not worthwhile at the moment.

Signage for Cycle Watch / Bike Watch **Action: Jay to send pdf of First Capital sign to Cathy for adapting**, WHBC Partnerships would pay half towards signage if we could get Herts Highways to contribute.

Bike Marking proved to be successful with 100 cycles marked over 2 days in Hydeway. Other events have been held at schools which were also successful, and 100 homes have been visited for marking of valuable items including cycles.

5 Any Other Business

- **Locality Budget:** The forum has received a response from Welwyn, the budget is spent but they are doing some of things we had asked for anyway.
- CW mentioned a Rail/Cycle working group who had £15m to spend nationally, Split between sustainable transport and Rail/cycle. **Action: CW to find and circulate details.** Possible monies to join up French Horn Lane route and improvements to cycle access at stations.

- Action: JS to send email regarding "New paths for communities" (Community Development Agency for Hertfordshire Paths Grant) http://www.cdaforherts.org.uk/funding/environmental/
- Ian gave feedback on his visit to Panshanger Park with regards to routes for walkers and cyclists for when the park is returned to public use after gravel extraction has been completed. The consensus of those that visited was that there should be more access points, and an east / west and north / south routes open to cyclists and horse riders. The Access Forum are pressing for more before quarrying finishes in 3 years.
- Big Lottery grant of £1100 has been approved conditional on accounts, bank details etc. a copy of the contract will be sent to Chairman and Secretary. We have to publish that we are "lottery funded" once grant is confirmed.
- Cycle Nation affiliation should continue it was agreed.
- CW introduced "Fresh Ways to Travel", sustainable travel for Herts County Council. **Action: CW to email details to AE to invite them to attend a meeting.**
- RM suggested that Doctor Bike attends as many events as possible and we ask for donations for any works carried out, this is to raise funds. **This was agreed.**

Ride descriptions

Amwell Nature Reserve

Sunday 26 February Start Morrisons Car Park, Black Fan Road, WGC, AL7 1RY 10h00.

Come with us to visit this nature reserve, internationally important for wintering wildfowl. Three hides allow you the chance to see many rare water birds and possibly some of the resident otters. Don't forget to bring a pair of binoculars. Full details on Ride approximately 28km there and back generally along off road cycle tracks. Facilities minimal on site. Be prepared for cold weather and muddy paths around the reserve. Lunchtime pub stop on return leg. Return before dark.

Shaw's Corner
