### **Ride Insurance**

The current CTC T&Cs for Affiliated groups state that there must not be more than 5 non *(WHCF)* members on any one ride, nor should a non *(WHCF)* member participate in a ride more than 5 times. However we do not want to turn people away.

Roger circulated 3 docs for discussion at the meeting (copies on Yahoo Messages 14<sup>th</sup> March) Membership Application Form, Revision of WHCF Constitution, Revision of Disclaimer.

Roger has registered our ride leaders with the CTC.

Several membership ideas were discussed -

- 1. First ride free then Annual WHCF membership on 2<sup>nd</sup> ride say £5 fee. More work to administer on renewal.
- 2. First ride free, day membership, say £1 per ride subsequent rides. Not too difficult. Would this be considered to be 'getting around the rules'?
- 3. Sign in on the day for automatic Life membership. Would this be considered to be 'getting around the rules'? Membership would lapse if non-contactable.
- 4. WHCF Membership cards, simple printed business type cards handwritten with each member's name. Membership cards were felt to have little merit. (However card owners may help spread the word, generate new WHCF website visits and introduce new riders)

Revision to Sign-in Sheet. Add emergency contact no. Action Roger.

Update. Roger contacted the CTC Insurers Butterworth Spengler who have confirmed that the 'no more than 5 non members' is a guideline and not a condition.

Although we are covered for rides, Publicity Stalls, not associated with rides, are only covered if they are specifically used to promote CTC.

However we can use the Bikeweek Insurance (available April to July inclusive) for the WHCF stall and any other 'non-ride' events.

The plastic recycle depot at the Lyon Way Industrial Estate on the Alban Way has allowed loose waste to be blown away. Chris to report to the Environment Agency and Hertsdirect. **Action Chris.** 

Chris explored the A414 riding on the south side from the Cole Green Underpass to Gypsy Lane. There is a possibility to convert the path into a cycle path. Can this path be added to the Cycleherts List for rural pavement conversion? **Action Adam.** Further detail is needed on the Gypsy Lane to the A1000 Hertford Rd section.

The 20mph EU petition has reached approx 16,000 signatures after 3 months. 1M are needed by the end of 2013.
